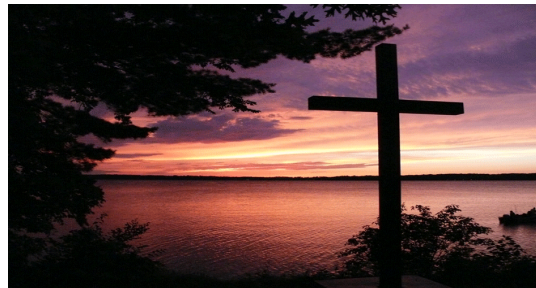

There will be a variety of workshops offered including:

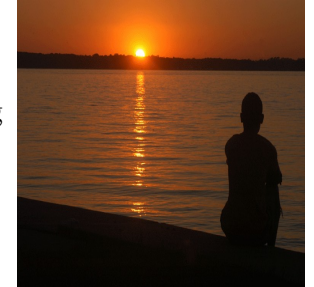
- Campers with special needs including ADHD and those on the Autism Spectrum
