

DR. JAKE SORENSON

Dr. Jacob Sorenson will present some of his findings and recommendations from the Effective Camp Research Project. Dr. Sorenson received his PhD in Practical Theology in 2016. During and following his studies, he has participated in numerous research projects, and he continues his work on scholarly research, education, and consulting.

DISCUSSION SESSIONS

A majority of our time is spent in discussion, picking each other's brains about relevant topics. We ask participants to share topics which most interest them, and use our common experience to work toward best practice in those areas.
